

Burlingame On the Avenue Announces Entertainment Lineup

New El Camino Stage Addition to the Main Stage Will Enhance Entertainment Experiences for all Festival Goers

(Burlingame, Calif., July 25, 2015)--- Burlingame On The Avenue has announced the complete entertainment lineup for the highly anticipated free summer festival, taking place on August 15-16 in the heart of downtown Burlingame.

Between both the Main Stage and El Camino Stage there will be 19 performances that will give festival goers an energized musical experience of the summer.

Showcasing their Folk, Rock, Jazz, and comedy talents is Devon McClive & Sons Band, opening on the Main Stage on August 15. Returning on the Main Stage is the Acoustic Rock band Group Therapy, based in Burlingame and playing the classic rock hits of the 70's. Closing out the Main Stage on August 16 is the spicy Latin/Dance group, Patron Latin Rhythms.

"Our efforts this year for our entertainment stages focused on finding very talented musicians with as many local connections as possible," said Wayne Wedgeworth. "Almost every performer this year has ties to our local area or have a history with the festival."

New to this year's Burlingame On the Avenue is the addition of more entertainment stages. Throughout both days, the Smooth Jazz and Reggae band GroWiser and the classical guitar experience of the John Clarke will bring new excitement to the El Camino stage experience.

Along with the musical performances, festival goers can enjoy a wide array of vendors, outdoor exhibitions and family-friendly activities. The event will also include a special kid's area featuring rides, entertainment, interactive games and children's activities.

"We also worked to assure that there is a wide diversity in styles," said Wedgeworth. "On our Main Stage and El Camino Stage, you'll find classic rock, alternative rock, blues, Latin, hi-energy 80s/90s rock, country, acoustic rock, R&B, jazz, smooth jazz, Hot Club de Paris jazz, gypsy, American roots and classical guitar."

Burlingame on the Avenue is one of the most highly regarded events on the Peninsula each summer. It is hosted by the Burlingame Chamber of Commerce and is free to the public. Attendees are encouraged to take advantage of convenient public transportation options including Caltrain and SamTrans.
